


Evidence for Education in Emergencies (E-Cubed)

E-Cubed: 3 Guiding Principles to Support Evidence for EiE



Gaps in evidence in crisis- affected contexts are best identified by those on the ground

Recognizing this, Dubai Cares and INEE do not pre-define a thematic or geographical focus for E-Cubed.



Evidence and knowledge are global public goods

E-Cubed's ambition is for all EiE stakeholders to be empowered by evidence. Therefore, E-Cubed generates evidence that is freely available with no restriction in access.



Local actors are at the center of the research process

E-Cubed supports research approaches that empower and build the capacity of local actors throughout the entire research process, from the identification of the research question(s), to research design, implementation, analysis, and dissemination.
