





RESULTS: Snapshots by December 2019



3.5M children (48% girls) reached with **wholechild approach** since inception (+3.9M in Yemen) in **29 countries (35** by September 2020)



► From 53% (2017) to 75% (2019) in Uganda ► From 62% (2018) to 67% (2019) in Ethionia

Improved Learning Outcomes

- ➢ 60% can read words (up from 11%) in Nigeria
- > 48% can read a story (up from 2%) in Afghanistan
- 43% can do 1/2-digit divisions (up from 0%) in
 Afghanistan







ECW TF - US\$252.8M mobilised in 2019 (US\$640M by 2020) US\$120M leveraged in-country in 2019



Increased humanitarian funding trends to education

- ➤ 2.6% in 2015; 5.1% in 2019.
- > OCHA Country-based Funds to education from 18% (2018) to 22% (2019)



Funding Requirements 2020/21:

- ECW TF: US\$300M
- In-Country: US\$900M
- Only 43% of humanitarian appeals funded for education
- US\$1.5 trillion funding gap in low/middle income countries before COVID19
